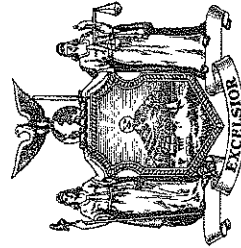

Additionally, you are required to complete and return, on or before the stated deadline, the quarterly reports that will be sent to you by DSDVBD.
